Our School

Vail Christian High School's mission, "Equipping Mind, Body, and Spirit for Lives of Purpose, Service, and Leadership," is guided by our core values of Excellence, Faith, Character, and Community. Situated along the Eagle River in Edwards, Colorado, VCHS offers a unique opportunity for high school students in the Vail Valley. Since its founding in 1998, VCHS has focused on maintaining high academic standards, preparing students for college and careers, and providing a safe environment in which students can explore and grow in their Christian faith. As an independent Christian high school, we are ecumenically diverse and warmly welcome families and students from all backgrounds.

Curriculum and Programs

VCHS offers 16 AP courses, many of which are part of the core VCHS curriculum for every student beginning in 10th grade. We value access to AP courses for all students, and that is why this year's pass rate percentage (3 or higher) is so astounding. With 248 exams administered, our students had an 81% pass rate. Of those students, 23 were named AP Scholars with Distinction (averaging 4.17) and 44 were named AP Scholars (averaging 3.75).

We are also a Project Lead the Way (PLTW) school offering two pathways, Engineering and Biomedical Science. PLTW courses are hands-on, project-based, and develop the skills needed for real-world problem-solving, especially in STEM college majors and careers. The PLTW exams involve real-world scenarios deepening critical thinking skills.

Our PLTW courses include Introduction to Engineering, Principles of Engineering, Aerospace Engineering, and Human Body Systems. With PLTW exams, we had an impressive 100% pass rate. Much like AP exams with their 1-5 scale, PLTW has Distinguished (5), Accomplished (4), and Practiced (3). Distinguished and Accomplished student recognition looked as follows: Introduction to Engineering (88%), Principles of Engineering (100%), and Human Body Systems (86%).

Vail Christian High School is accredited through the Council on Educational Standards and Accountability (CESA) and Cognia.
