If you have / had a child at VCHS you already have an online Renweb application account (this is your online application account NOT your ParentsWeb Account) - please click [HERE](#) to log into your existing online application account. After you create an account, click the next link to login to your account and "Create A New Student Application". You will then have the flexibility to log in and out of your account and access your open application.

3. Recommendation Forms & Official Release of Information

Recommendations from an Administrator, English Teacher and Math Teacher will be requested through your online application and returned directly to the Admissions office.

Please sign the Official Release of Student Records Form within the online application. Upon receipt of this form, the Director of Admissions will request the applicant's transcripts, standardized test scores and formal educational plans (if applicable).

4. Entrance Assessment

Vail Christian High School utilizes the PreACT 8/9 as an indicator for 9th grade readiness. This tool demonstrates growth over time and gauges academic fit during the critical transition into high school.

Dates are: January 23, February 6 and March 13, 2027.

**Students who take certain standardized placement exams may be exempt.*

5. Family Interview

This is the final step of the admissions process. The family interview is one way we are able to learn more about the applicant, but it also provides your family with another opportunity to get to know our school better. Interviews are conducted by the Head of School, Assistant Head of School or Dean of 9th Grade, and our Director of Admissions.
